

Bringing Children to Clinics

We recognise that due to the current isolation guidelines, you may need to bring your children to your clinic appointment with you.

Please be aware the following controls will need to be followed to ensure your appointment goes ahead smoothly.

- You and your children will be asked some pre-screening questions before you come into the clinic.
- If you answer yes to any of the questions asked, you will not be able to continue into the clinic for your appointment
- Any accompanying children will always need to remain with the patient. We do not recommend you leave your children in the reception area during your appointment, and to do so will be at your own risk.
- Please be aware, the children entering the clinic room, will need to sit down quietly
- Patients should be aware, for intimate scans, children should remain on the other side of the curtains during the scan and be trusted to remain seated quietly.
